Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Level I & Level II
Level I is for children ages 3 to 6 years. Level II is for children 6 years and older. This program uses Montessori techniques to allow children to explore the infinite mystery that is our God.

Released Time
Kids in grades 1-8 enrolled in New Lothrop Schools. Grades 1-4 meet twice a week for 45 minute sessions. Grades 5-8 meet once a week for a 55 minute session. The sessions begin in September and continue through the middle of May.

Members of St. Michael Parish whose children in grades 1-8 attend a school other than New Lothrop. Classes meet on Sundays from 9:30- 10:30 a.m. in the second story of the school building.

Sacramental Preparation
Children who are in the 2nd grade will be preparing for the following sacraments: Reconciliation in the Winter, Confirmation and First Eucharist in the Spring. Sacramental meeting times will be announced and are intended for parents as well as children.
